News from Partners Summer 2022 focus group

<u>News from Belgium</u>: After the last MyORCO meeting in Athens, we organised a focus group with OR nurse students in order to assess the MyORCO tool. The participants were enthusiastic about the tool and gave us some pertinent remarks for further improvements.

Christine Willems and Simon Dujardin (SpaceCowboyStudio) will continue to work together and will edit more videos that will be validated during the next meeting in September in Brussels. The next meeting will take place in Brussels on the 1st and 2nd of September. We are glad to welcome our partner in the capital of Europe. During the meeting, we will continue to work on the validation of the edited videos, the user guide and the website itself. The feedback received from the various focus groups organised by each partner will help us to further improve the MyORCO website. The dissemination and sustainability of the project will also be discussed. We are looking forward to welcome all our partners and we will keep you informed on the progress of the project in our next newsletter.

<u>News from Czech Republic</u>: We have organized several Focus Groups with students, perioperative nurses and OR managers. FG participants were very interested in all the presented topics. The MYORCO project was presented at XI. Congress of perioperative nurses in Pardubice. The congress took place in Pardubice on June 3-4. There were around 100 participants. 26 papers were presented in two days and six sessions.



The paper focused on MYORCO project was also presented at 9th Czech-Slovak Congress of Otorhinolaryngology and Head and Neck Surgery.

<u>News from Finland</u>: The first focus group of perioperative nursing students was arranged 7th of June 2022. We had eight participants and they actively made comments

about the videos and web page. The students find the videos useful to support the learning of practical skills. There were three teachers from JAMK University of Applied Sciences preset: Jaana Perttunen, Sinikka Holma and Pirkko Ratinen. The next two focus group interviews will be arranged in August.



News from France: After two years of suspension due to the COVID crisis, UNAIBODE, the French association of certified operating room nurses (IBODE), organized its annual congress in Reims on May 12 and 13, 2022. During two workshops, more than eighty IBODEs from all French hospitals were able to learn about the KSM approach, to discover the KSMOR application and the first modules of its successor carried by the European Erasmus project MYORCO. Considering the current situation in the operating rooms, which is accompanied by the departure of many operating room nurses, those present were able to measure the very practical and reassuring side of these approaches for the new personnel. With KSMOR and MYORCO, UNAIBODE's objective is confirmed: to facilitate and secure the integration of new nurses in the operating room

<u>News from Greece</u>: At the beginning of summer 2022, we welcomed Athens our MYORCO partners. During those two days' meeting, we were continuing the editing of the videos and discussed the first results from the focus group. The results from all the partners it was very positive and the majority of the participants found the videos particularly pedagogical.



<u>News from Sweden</u>: We presented the ERASMUS project MYORCO, My Operating Room Nurse Coach on the website of Karolinska University Hospital and the work meeting that was conducted in Athens where Pediatric Surgery/Children's OR-unit is involved. We highlighted the goal of the project, which is also expected to increase the quality of care and patient safety for all patients undergoing surgery, at Children's OR-unit, Astrid Lindgren Children's Hospital/Karolinska University Hospital, Stockholm, Sweden.
